Change of the application process from the summer semester 2021 onwards!

Citizens of non-EU countries (except applicants for Master's or Doctoral studies) have to submit the following documents: Application, approved and certified copy of a language certificate (e.g. DSH-2) and a **preliminary review documentation** (Vorprüfungsdokumentation, **VPD**) as an uncertified copy issued by uni-assist (www.uni-assist.de). You no longer have to submit certificates of your home educational institutions when you apply at the HHU.

PLEASE NOTE: The VPD must be issued specifically for the application at HHU Düsseldorf. A uni-assist review report is not sufficient. If you have passed an entrance assessment test (Feststellungsprüfung), you must submit the certificate to uni-assist so it can be considered in the VPD.

EU citizens are not affected by this regulation. As before, the application needs to be submitted with an approved and certified copy of a language certificate and your local educational certificates (in original version and German/English or French translation). All copies need to be officially certified.

Applications for the first semester (Medicine, Dentistry or Pharmacy) will be treated with a lower priority if the applicant has already completed one semester of same study programme at another German higher education institution.

Applications for the first semester in Medicine are not possible if at the time of the application the preliminary medical examination (Physikum) has already been taken or if you've already been given credit for the intermediate examination in Medicine (Erster Abschnitt der Ärztlichen Prüfung). In these cases you can only apply for the clinical stage (of studies).

- Only fully completed and signed application forms which include all necessary documents and which will be submitted within the application deadline can be considered in the application process.
- Any documents received at a later point cannot be matched to the applications we've already received and therefore cannot be considered in the application process.
- The proof of German language proficiency and the certificates from the educational institutions in your home country (including a list of your subjects and grades) must be submitted as officially certified copies. These certificates must be submitted in the original language version plus in a German, English or French version translated by a certified translator).
- To be admitted to a master's programme you must hold at least an undergraduate degree. Prior to applying for a place in a master's degree study programme you must contact the responsible department which will then check whether you fulfil the necessary qualifications (proof of aptitude - Feststellung der besonderen Eignung). Please check the homepage of the appropriate faculty to find out more about this process and application deadlines.
- To be admitted to a PhD programme, you need approval of the dean's office and confirmation of supervision by the doctoral supervisor.
- A photo is not mandatory.
