Points 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply for BIPs and Short-Term Mobility

Funding for short stays:

Day 5 – 14 of the in-person mobility: €79/day

Day 15 – 30 of the in-person mobility: €56/day

Green Travel: €50 allowance for travel costs + max. 4 additional daily allowances for travel days

Social Top-Up: up to 14 days of in-person mobility: one-time payment of €100, up to 30 days of in-person mobility: one-time payment of €150

- An allowance for travel costs dependent on the distance involved will be granted on application for the Social Top-Up
