Hi, my name is leva and I was an Erasmus student at HHU, Summer semester 2020.
 First of all, I have to say that my Erasmus experience at HHU was a little bit different from students' of other years. I didn't happen to stay in Düsseldorf for the whole semester (because of covid-19). So, I did not experience any lectures at the university itself – all I had were online lectures.

In my case, none of the professors made any video conference lectures (like Zoom ones or WebEx), so there were mainly two ways of learning: students received either slides that were relevant for the exam (sometimes with professor's audio) or we had a book that we needed to read for the exam.
 Speaking about contents of modules, they were quite hard. Sometimes the slides of modules were hard to understand (or I didn't have enough knowledge), but there was always an opportunity to write an email to the professor. And they really answered the questions fast and clearly, which was very nice and helpful.

All in all, professors at HHU are really friendly and willing to help. For me, as for Erasmus student, they did many exceptions. For instance, I was able to have my exams in English. Since I don't speak German fluently, having exams in English was a huge relief and not stressful at all. During exams, professors were very helpful and even elaborated and explained the concepts that I didn't understand.


