

This is a list of everything you will need to do at the start of your studies. It contains helpful hints of the first steps to take, along with links to further information.

To do	Purpose
<u>Activate your university username</u>	To access HHU's online systems (e-mail, study portal, etc.)
<u>Activate your HHU Card</u>	To receive the latest information from HHU (checking your e-mail is mandatory!)
<u>Set up your uni e-mail account</u>	View the course catalogue, access the ILIAS study portal, register for your exams and view your exam results
<u>Register in the study portal</u>	Your all-in-one student card, semester ticket, library card and canteen/cafeteria payment card
<u>Register in the E-Student-Services</u>	Print certificates of enrolment, change your contact details, file an application (e.g. for a semester on leave, change of subject, exmatriculation)
<u>Activate "eduroam" Wi-Fi</u>	To go online anywhere on campus
<u>Download our guide for first-year students (Ersti-Guide-App)</u>	HHU's orientation app
<u>Sign up for preparatory courses and the language placement test</u>	To prepare you for your studies involving foreign languages or natural sciences
<u>Attend the orientation event for your study programme</u>	To plan your timetable and obtain other important subject information
<u>Set up your study space at home</u>	Technical support and advice on studying at home

To do	Purpose
<u>Welcome Programme of the International Office</u>	Orientation for international students
<u>Exchange at the Lunch & Talk or Buddy-Programme</u>	Getting to know other international students

Additional Information for Students with Disabilities or Chronic Illnesses*:

To do	Purpose
<u>Accessibility</u>	Orientation on campus and information on accessibility
<u>Quiet rooms</u>	Quiet rooms on campus
<u>Accessible toilets</u>	Finding accessible toilets quickly on campus
<u>Special parking lots</u>	University parking permit for the use of disabled parking lots on campus
<u>Euro keys</u>	For opening and operating disabled-access elevators, ramps and toilets
<u>BlindSquare</u>	App for the orientation of visually impaired and blind people on campus
