THE GERMAN NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Heinrich Heine University Düsseldorf funding programme »Seizing Opportunities« – the German National Scholarship – is aimed at high-performing students from all faculties at HHU. You can apply from the 1st semester of your bachelor's studies up to completion of a master's programme or up to State Examination level. There is a special funding line for studying parents.

Scholarship recipients receive €300 in support per month for two semesters. This amount is financed equally by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) and private donors. In addition to the financial support, this programme offers scholarship recipients the opportunity to participate in events with "their" donors.

Apply for the German National Scholarship within the framework of the special funding line and secure additional funding on top of your financial support under the Federal Training Assistance Act (BAföG).

As a German National Scholarship recipient, you will gain insights into a broad spectrum of academic areas as well as social, cultural and economic life in the city of Düsseldorf and surrounding region.

When can you apply?

The application period runs from 1 July to 31 August 2024. Students in their first semester can apply up to 15 September 2024.
